#### Why we need you?

#### How much time do you need to commit?

Regular meetings over the year. These are held on week day evenings usually once a month; we have an additional one in May as well as two charity meetings a year. You do not need to attend every meeting.

As much time as possible over the weekend of the second Saturday in June, although this is not a requirement as we do have some committee member that cannot attend the gala.

#### What support will you be given?

We are hoping to recruit a Volunteer Coordinator who would take on looking after new committee members. Regardless you can speak to anyone else on the committee or the one of the officers. We work as a supportive team and help each other when workloads are high or life gets in the way.
